

Purpose and Activities of the Cape Town Academic Project

The main activities of the Project will be as follows:

- (i) Establish and maintain a library of resource materials on the Cape Town Convention, including its legislative history and other developmental materials, both in searchable, digitized form and in hard copy;
- (ii) Develop an on-line reporting system for cases and related legal activities relating to the Cape Town Convention;
- (iii) Publish a yearly Cape Town Convention Academic Journal, which will include articles and developments relating to the Cape Town Convention and could include papers from the conferences noted below;
- (iv) Organise and hold academic conferences on the Cape Town Convention, one being contemplated for each of years two and three of the Project;
- (v) Prepare teaching materials covering the Cape Town Convention, in particular (a) as modules for select commercial, comparative, transnational / international law courses, and (b) on the Cape Town Convention as a whole, for government officials, judges, and scholars; and
- (vi) Assess law and economic considerations relating to the Cape Town Convention.
